Started in 2016, and awarded "Best International Passport 2016" by The Austin Chronicle, the INDIE MEME FILM FESTIVAL is Indie Meme's signature event. IMFF continues to grow as the 'go to' destination for unique, powerful stories from South Asia & Iran. Indie Meme aims to entertain, educate, and engage the community through post screening audience & filmmaker Q&As and discussions.

Over 2,000 cinema enthusiasts come from all over Texas to Austin each year to watch the carefully curated programming and experience slices of life from South Asia & Iran, building a strong and diverse community of Meme-ers (Indie Meme Members)!

The 10th INDIE MEME FILM FESTIVAL will be hosted from April 9-13, 2025 in Austin, Texas. This 5-day festival will offer excellent cinema, filmmaker interactions, panel discussions, social events, and networking. Final Festival Programming is announced March 1st, and promotions throughout Central Texas begin. Your brand will be in front of an audience that appreciates art, culture, and community.



# IMFF VIRTUAL EDITION


**MAY 2-4, 2025** 

The 5th INDIE MEME FILM FESTIVAL (IMFF) pivoted to a virtual format in May 2020, just a month after the pandemic forced the cancellation of our in-person April festival. Members and patrons appreciated having films to enjoy and a platform to connect during a challenging time.

In 2021, we embraced the virtual format, creating a Virtual Festival Village to offer a dynamic experience for attendees and filmmakers, as indoor events remained rare.

From 2022 to 2024, we returned to in-person festivals while continuing virtual, on-demand options to ensure accessibility for seniors and immuno-compromised patrons.

Looking ahead, the HYBRID IMFF2025 will combine in-person and virtual events to engage audiences across Texas, including Houston, Dallas, and San Antonio. This expanded outreach builds on our virtual success and grows our presence beyond Austin. 
